Key facts:

- **28** bills considered under suspension of the rules; **1** bill considered from the corrections calendar
- Time the final list of *all* bills was circulated: **8:01pm**
- Number of bills passed by voice vote: **22** (that's three-quarters of the total number of bills under consideration that day)
- Number of bills brought to the House floor that were not first considered by the appropriate House committee: **15** (i.e. 52%)
- Total known[#] five-year costs of all bills passed: **\$27,036.8 million**
Percentage of these costs in bills passed by voice vote: **38%** (**78%** when excluding railroad retirement)
