RSC Announces Media Referral Service

Allows for “One-Stop Shopping” When Looking for Conservative Viewpoint

WASHINGTON—Rep. Sue Myrick (R-NC), Chairman of the Republican Study Committee (RSC), and Rep. Mike Pence (R-IN), Chairman of the RSC Communications Taskforce, today announced the creation of the **RSC Media Referral Service**.

The Media Referral Service is designed to link up inquiring journalists with conservative House Members. RSC, a caucus of more than 75 House conservatives, is maintaining a list of issues on which individual conservative Members can speak in the media. When members of the media could use a conservative viewpoint on any issue, they will now be able to come to the RSC for referrals to the appropriate congressional offices. This Service will reduce the need for the media to call dozens of offices in search of a congressman who can comment on a certain issue.

More than 30 conservative House Members are currently participating in this Service and can comment on dozens of issues, including:

- Homeland Security
- Human Cloning
- Iraq
- North Korea
- Judicial Nominee, Miguel Estrada
- Investigation into the Shuttle Columbia Explosion
