GENERAL PROVISIONS OF NOTE:

Dept of Energy Travel: The bill caps reimbursement of management and contractor travel at \$150 million.

Strategic Petroleum Reserve: The bill extends the authorization for the Strategic Petroleum Reserve to September 30, 2001.

Kyoto Protocol: The bill prohibits the use of funds to implement the Kyoto Global Warming Treaty
