## **Hayworth: President Made the Case; Now, Congress and UN Must Act**

WASHINGTON - Congressman J. D. Hayworth of Arizona issued the following statement in reaction to the speech by President George W. Bush at the United Nations:

**“The President made a comprehensive, carefully documented and compelling case that the regime of Saddam Hussein must be dismantled and its reign of terror ended.**

**“The Congress and the United Nations now have a clear choice that will define the character, integrity and legitimacy of these institutions. They can either recognize the overwhelming evidence of the real and present danger that Saddam Hussein poses and resolve to deal effectively and immediately with that threat, or they can continue to accept and accommodate his tyrannical disregard for human life, peace, and the rule of law.”**
